






#### Greetings Neighbor,

We hope that this letter finds you well and enjoying your summer. Davisville Free Library is thrilled to see old friends come back to our library while we welcome new friends and expand our community. Everyone knows the past few years have been tough, but with your support, the library has been able to adapt and weather the challenges. We are grateful for the flexibility, encouragement, and generosity of the community. We hope that you will continue to support Davisville Free Library in the 2023 Annual Appeal Drive this summer. With more than half of our budget coming from community donations, your help is essential to keep Davisville Free Library's doors open! As an added in centive, The Herman H. Rose Civic, Cultural and Media Access Fund will award 8% if the library is successful in raising \$23,000, or 11% if successful in reaching your stretch goal of \$25,000.

Your fully tax-deductible donation of any amount will help the library continue to provide valuable resources and services to patrons in our community. In addition, you will help fund engaging, on-going programs such as our popular Storytime and Music & Movement programs, craft nights, book clubs, author visits, delivery of library materials to homebound patrons, technology access and instruction, access to materials from other Ocean State libraries, and so much more.

Over this past year, Davisville Free Library served roughly 6500 community members and provided a summer of exciting adventures in reading. In June, we kicked off our summer reading program with the theme, Find Your Voice! Throughout the rest of the summer, we hosted special events for all ages, including art programs, crafternoon, Fiddle n' Fun, a tiny art show, and more!

This fall we are bringing back our Trivia Night evening fundraiser with prizes for the trivia winners and loads of raffle items! All proceeds go to the Davisville Free Library.
