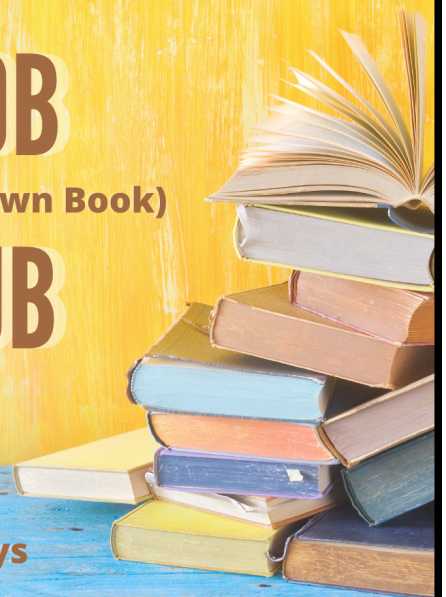

Thank you for being a part of the Davisville Free Library community! We hope that this letter finds you well and enjoying your fall. As we kick off our 2025 Annual Appeal, we wanted to update you on all the fun and engaging events that were possible because of your generosity! Here are some of the highlights of this past year.

In June, we kicked off our gaming themed summer reading program “Level up!”, with reading and events for library members of all ages. Our summer events included a presentation from the Audubon Society of Rhode Island on turtles, an escape room for tweens, family book cover BINGO, and a variety of art and craft events. Spring events included the popular Ukrainian egg painting workshop, family game nights, and painting events. The library also launched a monthly program featuring art and photographs from local artists! The Book & Bake sale in May brought library patrons and the neighborhood together and we look forward to its Autumn counterpart in November. Also, this spring, the library improved accessibility by renovating the front steps. Thank you for supporting and being a part of all of these wonderful activities, resources, and events!

The library continues to provide essential resources and services to patrons in our community. Your contribution will help the library to continue our on-going programming such as our popular Storytime and Music & Movement programs, craft nights, book clubs, author visits, book delivery to homebound patrons, technology access and instruction, exchange of materials from other Ocean State libraries, and so much more! Last year Davisville Free Library served 7,390 patrons, many of whom rely on our location for physical access to our state’s library network.

We are grateful for your generosity and active support of the library. We weathered the pandemic but as we look forward, we anticipate new challenges in Davisville Free Library’s future. Costs for supplies and utilities continue to increase and uncertainty remains for nonprofits.
